Per USP 795, one must conduct extensive stability testing to justify Beyond Use Dating (BUD) in excess of 30 days for an aqueous topical compound. One option is to provide your patient with a nonaqueous vehicle. USP 795 allows a BUD of 180 days for nonaqueous vehicles according to the professional judgment of the pharmacist. Most commercially available nonaqueous topical bases are derived from petrolatum or lanolin. Patients often find these heavy bases unsatisfactory. Letco Medical's new Anhydrous Cream offers a solution.
